



Concerto Competition Information

- 1) Candidates should choose one movement of a concerto for the competition. The concerto may be selected from any period of classical music. **Before preparing a work for the Competition**, please consult with the Music Director regarding the choice of concerto. Though it would be rare for a piece to be unfeasible, some particularly difficult works, or works that call for especially large or unusual instrumentation, may be unsuitable.
- 2) Auditions are to be performed with piano accompaniment (including piano concertos). The accompanist must be a professional pianist. SCCYS staff will be happy to help put students in touch with excellent accompanists upon request. A high-quality piano will be available at the audition site. It is highly recommended that auditioners arrange multiple rehearsals with their accompanist before the competition.
- 3) Participants should submit an official entry form no later than one month prior to the competition. A schedule for auditions will be created and distributed to participants two weeks prior to the audition date.
